# What do commissioners do?

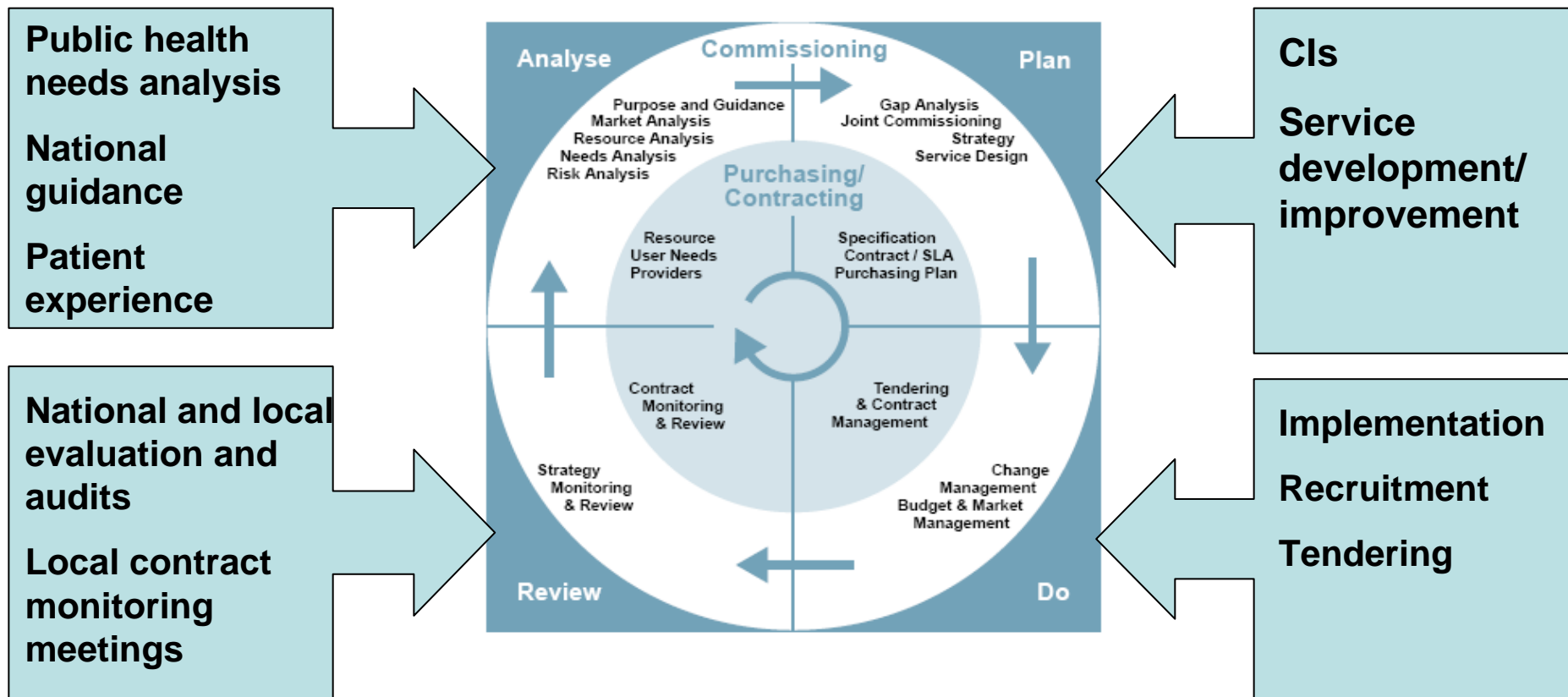


***‘process of deciding what services or products are needed, acquiring them and ensuring that they meet requirements’***

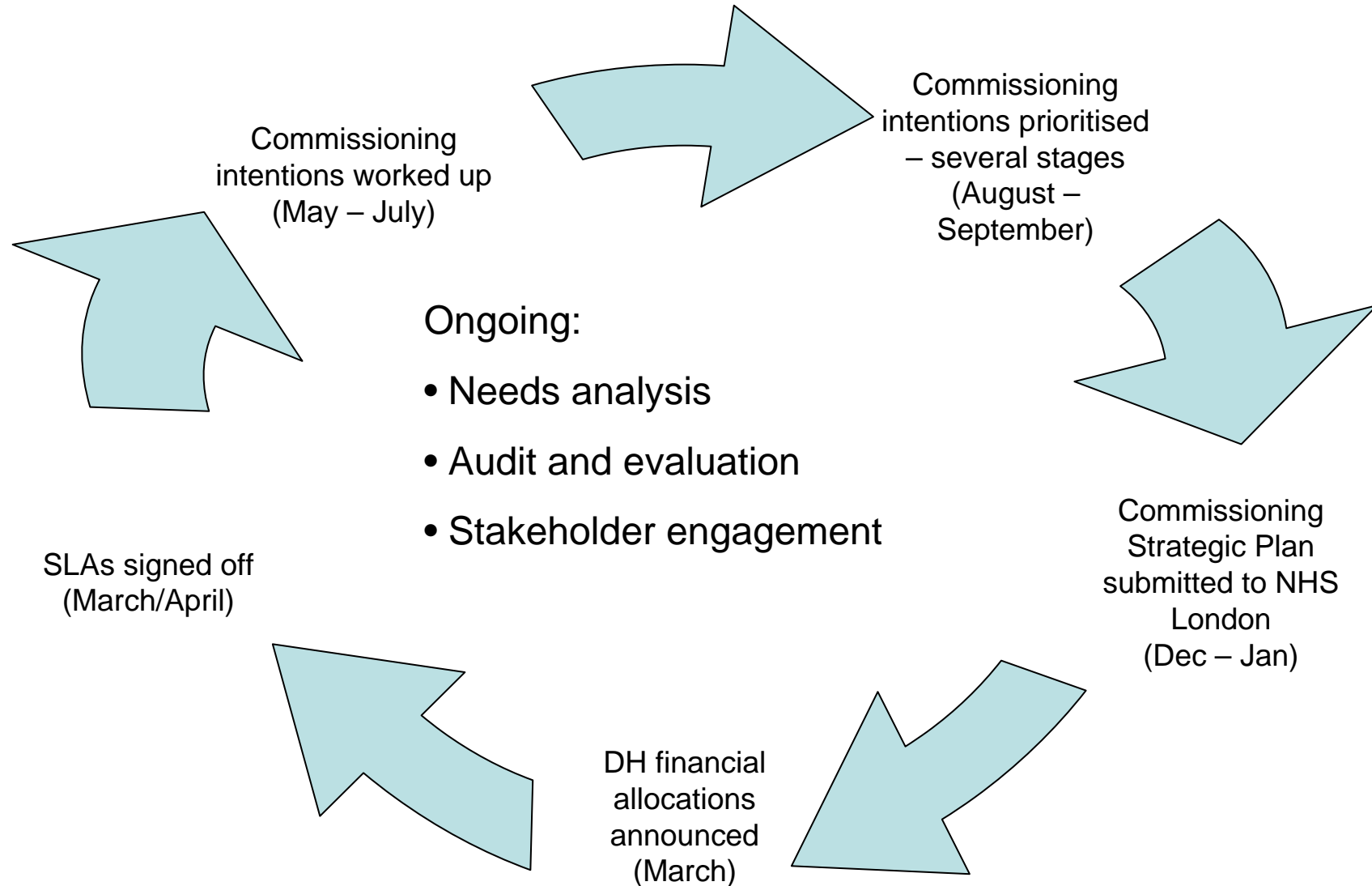
***‘identifying, quantifying, monitoring and evaluating, a service within the NHS’*** *Manchester PCT*

# World class commissioning and cardiac rehab

## - 11 World class commissioning competencies:

- locally lead the NHS
- work with community partners
- engage with public and patients
- collaborate with clinicians
- manage knowledge and assess needs
- prioritise investment
- stimulate the market
- promote improvement and innovation
- secure procurement skills
- manage the local health system
- make sound financial investments

# Challenges

- Developing community-based services to meet local need
  - Gender, age, language, ethnicity
- Split provision/commissioning of phases
- Tariff development – how do we cost the service (phase 1 included in acute tariff)
- Data vs information



# Opportunities

- Prevention of CVD should be top of everyone's priorities
  - Think beyond local PCT to PbC, NHS Health Checks
- Strong evidence base
- Standards of practice – BACR, NICE guidelines, NSF, SIGN
- Functional goals

# Working together

- Find out who your commissioner is
- Understand the strategic aims of the PCT and how your service could contribute
- Understand local prevalence and need
- Be clear about outcomes and impact
- Champion data collection, evaluation and audit
- Benchmark!
- Emphasise the evidence base
- Think about how to market your service
- Patient involvement
