

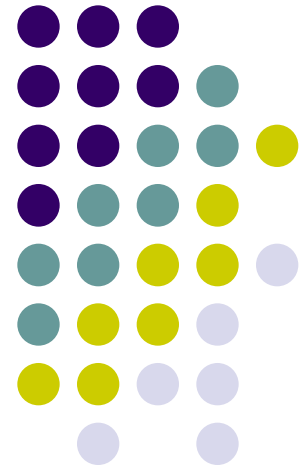

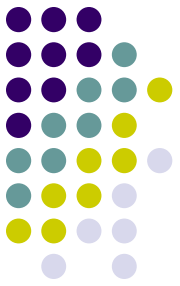
A sector wide approach

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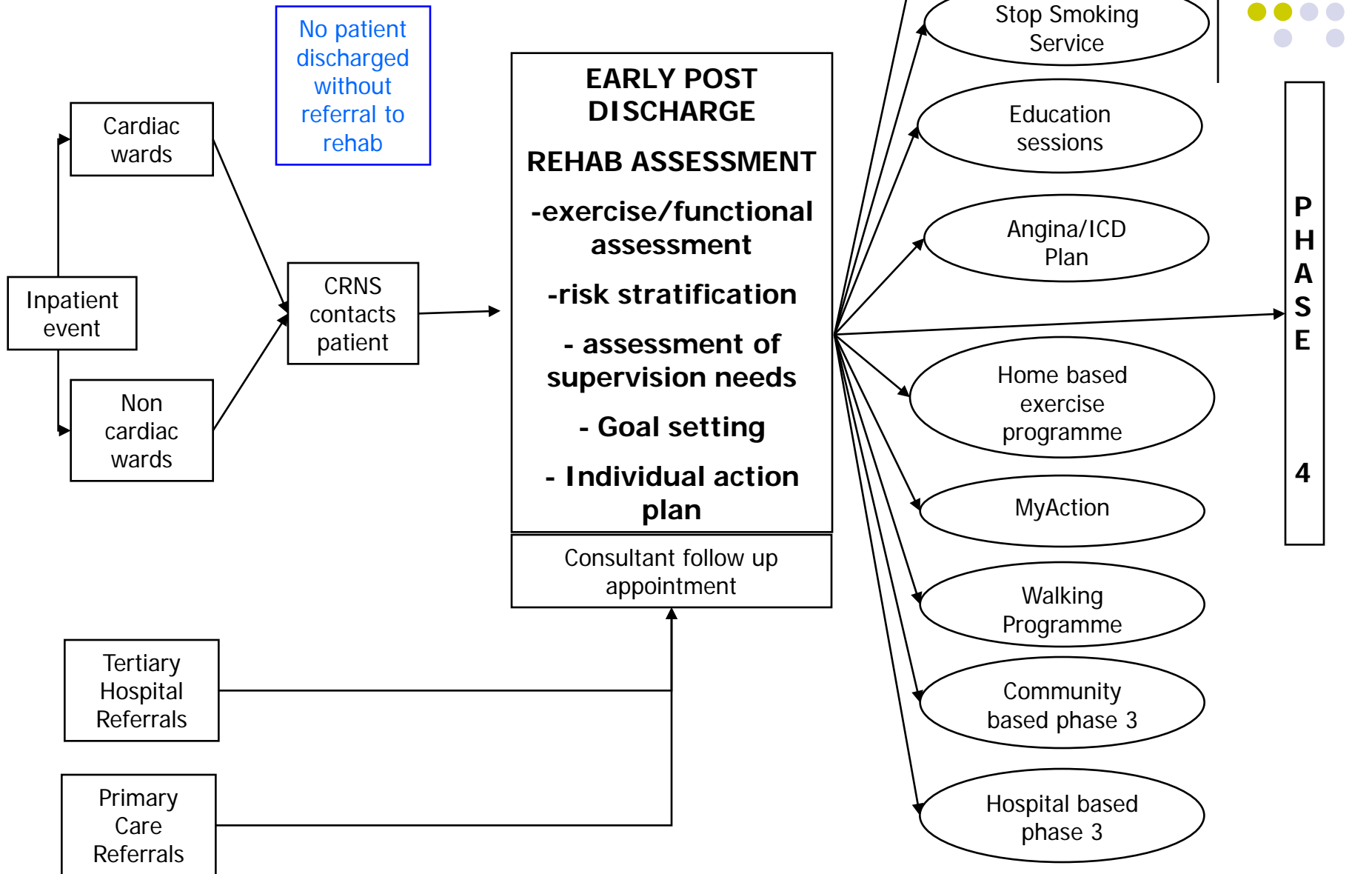


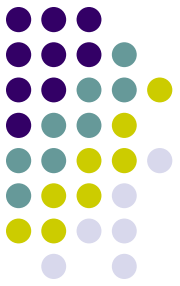


Background to our approach

- Baseline assessment and retrospective audit gave an indication of gaps / inequalities in local cardiac rehabilitation services
- Informed by research findings and local patient feedback
- Direction of travel for cardiac rehabilitation
- Strategic fit

Network model





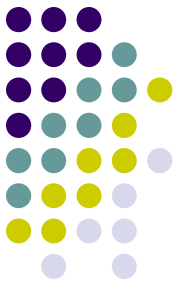
National Priority Project - Aims

- To improve access to, and uptake of, cardiac rehabilitation for all groups of cardiac patients
- To reduce inequalities throughout the sector
- To help integrate rehab within the cardiac pathway and ensure patients have the right support at the right time in their pathway
- To ensure providers and commissioners are working together to ensure that appropriate services are planned, developed and commissioned for local populations

National Priority Project - Approach



- Task group – sign up to this approach and quality assurance role
- Piloting initiatives with robust evaluation and roll out as appropriate
- Incorporating this approach into local service redesign work
- Cross cutting themes – education and patient & carer involvement



National Priority Project – Workstreams

- **Patient groups**
HF, ICD, Stable Angina, Target populations
- **Delivery methods**
Home based rehab, rehab led follow up, drug therapy reviews
- **Integration with other services**
Phase 4 mapping, developing and strengthening onward referral links
- **Workforce**
Supporting business case development, skills competencies assessment in relation to new pathway
- **NACR**
Increasing use, use of functionalities, electronic referral and using additional fields for action planning
- **Commissioning**
Impact modelling, pan London event, quality criteria, provider-commissioner discussions



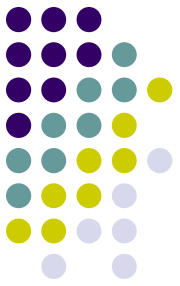
National Priority Project – Where are we now?

- Plans in place for future initiatives

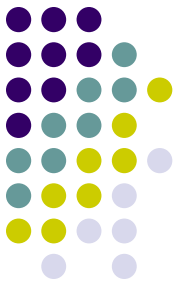
CHALLENGES:
