



CHRONIC HEART FAILURE: PRINCIPLES OF CARE MANAGEMENT

This module is relevant to Health Care Professionals currently managing patients with chronic heart failure, and in recognition that those accessing the programme will have unique academic profiles and life long learning needs. The student will be required to identify a work place mentor prior to the course commencing.

CONTENT

Epidemiology, anatomy and pathophysiology related to chronic heart failure. Investigations, diagnosis, holistic clinical assessment and history taking skills, signs and symptoms and evidence base for management.

In depth pharmacological and non-pharmacological management of CHF patients.

Co morbidities, exercise, nutrition medico legal issues and an overview of supportive and palliative care.

ACCREDITATION

The module is offered at SHE/SCQF9: 40 credits and Msc/SCQF11: 30 credits.

This module will be offered by Glasgow Caledonian University in Semester A and B. It will be delivered using a range of learning environment including self directed learning, online learning and classroom teaching.
